

Heavy Equipment & Site Construction Technology — Main Campus 600 hours

This program will introduce students to Heavy Equipment Operation and Site Construction. Curriculum will cover plan reading, 10hr.OSHA Safety Training, GPS Training, stakes and grades, NCCER core curriculum, soils and soil compaction, grade checking equipment and construction safety.

Students will have hands-on operation with 10 pieces of heavy equipment which will cover operations for NCCER certification. The last 80 to 120 hours will be an externship with a contractor out in the field. **Students must have a high school diploma or a GED to qualify for the class.**

Tuition includes: Hard hat, Boots, Clothing, 4 Books and Uniforms. There will be a \$60.00 Application Fee.
